STRATEGIC PLAN FOCUS AREA: Quality of Life means enhancing public safety, infrastructure, connectivity, and recreational space and programs the Town maintains for its residents.

SUMMARY/BACKGROUND:

Since 2009, the Town of Prescott Valley has had an agreement with the Yavapai County Humane Society for housing of animals found at-large by the Town's Animal Services officers. The Agreement is proposed to be renewed for three years at a 12% increase from the prior cost.

RECOMMENDED MOTION:

Motion to approve a renewed Agreement with the Yavapai County Humane Society for animal control services for three years at a 12% increase. **VOTE.**

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends approval of the renewed Agreement with the Yavapai County Humane Society for animal control services.

FISCAL ANALYSIS:

Staff has negotiated a 12% increase that is in line with the increase that has been applied to the Humane Society's agreement with the City of Prescott and Yavapai County for the same services. Staff believes it is in the Town's interest to contract for these services through a third-party rather than try to operate its own animal facility.
